

Francesca da Rimini. The story of the adulterous lovers Paolo and Francesca in canto V of Dante's Inferno has been the basis of several comps.: (1) Symphonic fantasy by Tchaikovsky, Op.32, 1876, based on picture by Doré. (2) Opera in 4 acts by Zandonai to lib. by T. Ricordi after play by d'Annunzio (1902), after Dante's.

This work was originally planned as an opera based on the story from Dante's Inferno, but eventually Tchaikovsky decided to make it purely an orchestral work. It premiered in Moscow in March 1877.
